## BACKGROUND

The International Training Centre of the International Labour Organization (ITCILO) has been at the forefront of investing in human capabilities and institutional capacities since its inception in October 1964 and start of its activities in 1965. Throughout its six decades of activities as the capacity development arm of the ILO, the Centre has been pioneering learning, training and capacity development services for the changing world of work, providing state-of-the-art services for ILO tripartite constituents as well as other stakeholders and partners, and advancing capacity development as a core function of the United Nations Development System.

To celebrate its **60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary, the International Training Centre of the International Labour Organization** (ITCILO), is convening the **Pioneers Forum**. The Pioneers Forum will bring together ILO partners and constituents, UN agencies, development partners, academia, distinguished ITCILO alumni, learners and stakeholders. It will serve as a multistakeholder platform to review how advances in the field of learning, training and capacity development can be leveraged to scale progress on sustainable development. It will further highlight the need for **redoubling investments at in human and institutional capabilities** as a core priority for advancing decent work and human-centred approaches to social development at the global, national and local levels.

# **OBJECTIVES**

In the context of the UN common approach to Capacity Development, the Pioneers Forum has the following objectives:

- To provide an inclusive platform to showcase the role of learning and capacity development as central strategies to advance social justice through decent work.
- To review advances in the field of learning and training and discuss how these can be leveraged for catalytic impact at individual, institutional and system levels.
- To raise awareness on the contribution of capacity development services in advancing social development as part of the preparation of the Second UN World Summit for Social Development.

# FORMAT

The Pioneers Forum will consist of the following segments:

#### **High-level event (Day 1)**

The High-level segment will take place on Day 1 and will be held at the UN Turin Campus. It will be delivered in hybrid format and consist of the following sessions:

- A **high-level dialogue** on the role of learning and capacity development in the context of UN Pact for the Future and the UN 2.0 Quintet of Change.
- The **Pioneers Award Ceremony** celebrating ITCILO alumni who have made significant contributions to social justice.
- Two interactive panel sessions on (i) the **nexus between foundational technologies**, **learning and sustainable development**, and on (ii) tripartite approaches on the role of learning in connecting **values and leadership to advance human-centred system change**.
