## Follow-up to the recommendations of the Chief Internal Auditor for the year ended 31 December, 2021

## I. Introduction

- 1. The Chief Internal Auditor of the International Labour Office (ILO), also the Internal Auditor of the Centre, presented at the 85th Session of the Board (October 2021) a report in which he explained that due to the COVID-19 pandemic, it was not possible to visit the Centre in order to carry out any planned audit work during the 2020 year.
- 2. However IAO had initiated an online audit of the pre-qualification phase of the tendering process to select a qualified building contractor to renovate the Africa 10 and 11 pavilions and that the results would be communicated to the Centre in his Report ending on 31 December 2021<sup>1</sup>.
- **3.** As there were no audit recommendations issued during the year 2021, there is no follow-up information to be provided to the Board, in this Session.
- **4.** The Centre continues to work with the IAO and to keep the Chief Internal Auditor informed on the progress of the implementation of past outstanding recommendations.
