WHAT

WHAT TOPICS DOES THIS COURSE COVER?

The course draws on theories of situated and networked learning and provides an overview of the different design and evaluation challenges for open learning contexts. Its activities will help learners to build a theoretical foundation, providing also instruments for designing and conceptualizing open online education opportunities (MOOCs). From a more applied perspective, participants will also explore the topic of open licensing while sharing their learning resources.

Participants learn how to:

- Define why Open Education is relevant;
- Identify the different options for development and implementation of Open Education;
- Understand evaluation approaches for Open Online Education;
- · Identify challenges and define solutions for scalability.

- Learn how to design and implement options for Open Education;
- Explore evaluation approaches for Open Online Education;
- Identify challenges and define solutions for scalability.
