## OVERVIEW

### INTRODUCTION TO THE GLOBAL EVENT

The Global Forum is an annual event that opens a dialogue amongst key actors in the maritime industry focusing on key aspects related to the implementation of the MLC, 2006 as amended. The event provides an international forum where all stakeholders can discuss recent updates, technical issues and main challenges faced by the maritime sector, with a specific focus on the impact on decent working conditions and quality of shipping. It is organized to offer an interactive platform for sharing knowledge, experience and good practices facilitated by international experts. The programme is designed to engage participants in immersive debate to analyse also critical aspects in the implementation of the MLC, 2006 at national level. Throughout the programme, participants can step back from their daily professional life and reflect on what key issues mean in the maritime working environment.

## WHAT

### WHAT WILL I GAIN FROM THE EVENT?

The three-day knowledge sharing event aims to analyse and discuss the recent developments and the future perspectives in the context of the MLC, 2006.

## HOW

### HOW IS THE EVENT ORGANIZED?

The e-learning programme will be interactive and participatory and will be structured as follows:

- **Plenary sessions** (tentatively from 13.00 to 14.00 CET) on key topics with the involvement of international experts;
- **Group work** including interactive discussions on case studies, facilitated by e-coaches, followed by presentation of key findings (schedule will be arranged according to the time-zone of each geographic group);
- **Wrap up** (30 minutes).

# REQUIREMENTS FOR A PROFITABLE PARTICIPATION

The event is offered in English through the ZOOM platform. A good command of the working language is required as well as a good internet connection.

## CERTIFICATION

On completion of the Global Forum, participants will receive a certificate of attendance issued by the International Training Centre of the ILO.

## **WITHDRAWAL, CANCELLATION POLICY, AND REFUNDS FOR OPEN COURSES**

If an enrolled participant wishes or must withdraw from a course, they may choose to apply to a different course or be substituted by another candidate. The participant must notify the Centre, in writing, of their decision at least 14 days prior to the start date of the course. Cancellation of participation in regular courses will result in the following penalties:

- 14 days or more prior to the start date of the course: No penalty, 100% refund of amount paid less applicable bank charges
- 8 to 13 days prior to the start date of the course: Penalty of 50% of course price, refund of residual amount paid (if any) less applicable bank charges
- 7 days or less prior to the start date of the course: Penalty of 100% of course price.
