SNAPSHOT OF THE COURSE

Launched in June 2026, UNDIS 2.0 is the next, more ambitious phase of the United Nations Disability Inclusion Strategy (adopted 2019) — the foundation for transformative progress on disability inclusion across the UN's programmes and operations, and every pillar of its work.

This capacity-building programme equips UNDIS country team and entity focal points to advance disability inclusion through the UNDIS 2.0 framework. The course includes live virtual sessions with international experts and self-guided online modules, covering strategies and tools for identifying and addressing obstacles to achieving disability inclusion in their work context. The programme has been collaboratively designed by the ITCILO, the ILO-Gender, Equality, Diversity and Inclusion Branch, and the Disability Inclusion Team in the Executive Office of the Secretary-General.

WHAT TOPICS DOES THIS COURSE COVER?

In this learning journey, you will be taken through five modules. Main topics include:

- Key concepts, definitions and approaches to disability inclusion;
- International standards and frameworks and how they can be used to promote and implement disability inclusion efforts;
- UNDIS: history, purpose, structure and practical applications;
- An overview of actions, tools and partnerships to successfully mainstream disability inclusion across programmes and operations.

In particular, this course will equip you with the tools to:

- Understand UNDIS 2.0—its five priorities and 19 indicators;
- Deepen your knowledge of key disability inclusion principles;
- Build your confidence to advance inclusion and take action;
- Connect with experts and peers across the UN system;
- Develop a practical year-one implementation plan and take away tools to support your work.

WITHDRAWAL, CANCELLATION POLICY, AND REFUNDS FOR OPEN COURSES

If an enrolled participant wishes or must withdraw from a course, they may choose to apply to a different course or be substituted by another candidate. The participant must notify the Centre, in writing, of their decision at least 14 days prior to the start date of the course. Cancellation of participation in regular courses will result in the following penalties:

- 14 days or more prior to the start date of the course: No penalty, 100% refund of amount paid less applicable bank charges
- 8 to 13 days prior to the start date of the course: Penalty of 50% of course price, refund of residual amount paid (if any) less applicable bank charges
- 7 days or less prior to the start date of the course: Penalty of 100% of course price.
